Medical Action Myanmar (MAM) is a medical organization. MAM aims to improve access to quality health care for all people in Myanmar. MAM provides large-scale access to prevention, diagnosis & treatment of HIV, Malaria, Tuberculosis and we provide Basic Health Care. We support over 2000 Village Health Workers in diagnostic testing and treatments. A basic health care package is provided to deal with the most common diseases, and referral for complicated cases is supported. MAM is also running 12 clinics for HIV, HCV, TB and general health in sub-urban and in remote areas in Yangon, Karen, Mon, Sagaing and Kachin states. MAM employs over 850 staff.

Main responsibility

Under the supervision of clinic team leader, overall responsibility is to support and assist the primary health care and ill case management including probable covid cases with high quality service. Responsible to work at an integrated clinic, located in Kawkareik, mainly providing generally ill patients including Covid-19 suspected cases and other diseases.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Apply medical knowledge and skills to diagnose and treatment to generally ill patients prescribing the necessary treatment by Physician.
- Keep the patient and/or his/her family informed about the illness and provide appropriate explanations about the treatment to follow, checking they have understood.
- Follow up the evolution of the hospitalised/ill patients, through daily visits, consultations and examinations, prescribing the necessary treatment, deciding whether they can be discharged or transferred to other departments – in collaboration with other hospital or specialist clinic for patient's evolution.
- Check and control the rational distribution of medicines and equipment under his/her responsibility and take care the quality, disinfection and sterilization of the medical material. Assure general compliance with standing hygiene standards.
- Timely informing the line manager or Physician about any problem or complication of the patients' illness, medical error and monitors the proper functioning of the department, equipment or material.
- Ensure ongoing training of the medical/paramedical multidisciplinary team in order to optimise the quality of care.
- Knows and ensures universal precautions are followed at all times and improving infection control. Ensures professional confidentiality is respected.
- Manage the team under his/her direct responsibility according to MAM HR policies and procedures, supervising their performance, organising and scheduling shifts and rotations, directly participating in emergencies and on calls if necessary.

Other Responsibilities

- Work in infectious conditions such as isolation units with strict rules of infection prevention and control including the use of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) if needed.
- Work in duty shifts including night duties when circumstances arise.
- Other clinical duties as assigned

Training & Development:

- Maintain professional knowledge and competence.
- Attend mandatory training days/courses, on or off site, as and when required.
- Participate in relevant training to achieve required qualifications.
